**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING PETITION DEFICIENT AND  
ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the July 24, 2023 petition of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 222 appealing the City of Fulshear's wholesale water rates.

On August 23, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness.

The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively incomplete and deficient. By September 20, 2023, the petitioner must cure the deficiencies identified in the August 23, 2023, memorandum of Joseph Cooper, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

By October 19, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition and Fulshear may file a response to the petition. By October 19, 2023, petitioner, Fulshear, and Commission Staff must confer and file comments on how this proceeding should be processed and propose a procedural schedule.
