EV programs pay drivers to ditch gas cars

Colorado drivers bought 9,446 electric vehicles in the most recent quarter, but Carrie Ativeh is particularly psyched about 45 of them.

Atiyeh, associate director of transportation fuels and technology at the Colorado Energy Office, is one of the architects of the state's Vehicle Exchange Program, which hands out a rebate of up to \$6,000 to anyone who buys a new EV while surrendering a combustion-engine car. The program, which launched in late August, saw 45 people cash in a clunker by the end of September.

Scrappage policies like Colorado's are gaining traction in the U.S. as a 2-for-1 carbon bargain, a tidy way to catalyze clean car

purchases while canceling out chines. Vermont authorized a some of the least efficient ma-scrappage program in 2021; Cali-

fornia did in 2014.

In all three states, policymakers have mobilized around a simple calculation: If governments are going to dole out monev to boost EV adoption, why not tie it to getting rid of gas guz-

"It's a really cool kind of holistic approach to getting these high-emission vehicles off the road." Ativeh says.

The timing of such programs is propitious, as high prices hamstring widespread EV adoption. The U.S. also has more vehicles to scrap than ever. Between 2011 and 2021, the number of registered vehicles in the country surged to 282 million, an increase of almost 12%. Over the same time period, licensed drivers rose 10%.

Part of that disconnect is simple: Americans like buying new

cars, particularly when there's a strong economy and one of the strongest labor markets in history. Almost 28 million U.S. households now own three or more vehicles, a 16% increase from five years ago.

But the long tail of U.S. auto ownership is also extending. Over the past 10 years, the average age of a car on the road rose 9% to 12.2 years. For every silent new Tesla getting tucked into a garage, there's a wheezing Ford Explorer rolling off the used car lot or a geriatric Hummer finding a second home via Facebook Marketplace.

In other words, the clunkers are dving hard. That threatens to slow the time it will take for the U.S. to electrify its entire fleet, especially since the newest gas cars are some of the most re-

Stocks struggled after a rally that sent the market toward one of its biggest melt-ups of the last 100 years, putting the S&P 500 near "overbought" levels.

Industrial and financial shares underperformed. Amazon.com Inc. led gains in retailers as Cyber Monday kicked off.

Quadvest has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 for the provision of retail water and sewer utility service in Harris County, Texas.

The requested area overlaps the district boundaries of Coastal Water Authority, Gulf Coast Authority, Harris County Flood Control District, North Harris County Regional Water Authority, Port of Houston Authority. If these districts do not request a public hearing, the Commission shall determine that the district is consenting to the Quadvest's request to provide retail water and sewer utility service in the requested area.

Requested Area 1:

The requested area 1 includes <u>0</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>2.7</u> mile(s) <u>north</u> of downtown <u>Waller</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Castle Road</u>; on the east by <u>Fields Store Road</u>; on the south by <u>Knebel Road</u>; and on the west by <u>Farm to Market 362</u>.

The requested area 1 includes approximately <u>207.1</u> acres, comprised of uncertificated area to amend (add) to Quadvest, LP (CCN Nos. 11612 & 20952).

Requested Area 2:

The **requested area 2** includes <u>0</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>2.3</u> mile(s) <u>north</u> of downtown <u>Waller</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Knebel Road</u>; on the east by <u>Stokes Road</u>; on the south by <u>Waller Springs Road</u>; and on the west by <u>Fields Store Road</u>.

The requested area 2 includes approximately <u>187.9</u> acres, comprised of uncertificated area to amend (add) to Quadvest, LP (CCN Nos. 11612 & 20952).

Total Requested Area 1 & 2:

The total requested area 1 & 2 includes approximately 395 acres, comprised of uncertificated area to amend (add) to Quadvest, LP (CCN Nos. 11612 & 20952).

See enclosed maps showing the requested area.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter

requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a large-scale map, a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land, landowner's name, address, email address and fax number, if applicable.

A landowner that opts out from the requested area releases the applicant's obligation to provide retail water or sewer utility service to the removed land for any reason.


