COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On July 26, 2023, Quadvest, LP (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its certificates of convenience and necessity numbers 11612 and 20952 in Harris County. Quadvest filed supplemental information on July 28, 2023, August 16, 2023, October 16, 2023, December 7, 2024 and December 14, 2024.

On January 18, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 6, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice by January 23, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires more time to verify that the supplemental notice information filed by Quadvest comports with applicable rules. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests an extension of time until January 29, 2024.
