COMMISSION STAFF’S SIXTH REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On July 26, 2023, Quadvest, LP (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its Certificates of Convenience and Necessity numbers 11612 and 20952 in Harris County under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.242 through 13.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 through 24.237. Quadvest filed supplemental information on July 28, 2023, August 16, 2023, October 16, 2023, December 7 and 14, 2023, and February 16, 2024.

On March 20, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 10, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to the applicant for review and consent by March 26, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION AND MOTION FOR AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Currently, Staff is waiting for the ALJ to approve the tariff in Docket No. 54047, which will affect the present docket. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests an extension of time until April 17, 2024 for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to the applicant for review and consent.

Staff provides a proposed amended procedural schedule below:

Event	Date
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicant for review and consent	April 17, 2024
Deadline for applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission; deadline for the parties to request a hearing	April 24, 2024

If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	May 1, 2024
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence along with proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	May 8, 2024

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the foregoing.
