ORDER NO. 6
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of the August 7, 2023 application of SP Utility Company, Inc. and Municipal Operations, LLC for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County. On August 8 and 25 and December 8, 2023, SP Utility filed supplements to the application.

On February 13, 2024, SP Utility filed the signed affidavits of Harrison Williams, president of SP Utility, attesting that notice was mailed to all current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on January 11, 2024, and that there are no landowners owning tracts of land over 25 acres wholly or partly inside the requested area.

On February 15, 2024, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule applies for the continued processing of this docket:
