**ORDER NO. 5
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On January 22, 2024, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application, notice, and proposed a procedural schedule.


