**ORDER NO. 7  
GRANTING EXTENSION**

On April 26, 2024, Commission Staff filed an agreed request for extension to file a joint motion to admit evidence and a proposed order approving the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed. The parties' deadline to file the joint motion and proposed order was also April 26, 2024. Commission Staff states that the parties require additional time to draft and finalize the joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order.

The administrative law judge grants the extension. By May 6, 2024, the parties must file a joint motion to admit evidence and a proposed order approving the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed, including proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.
