ORDER NO. 14
REQUIRING STATUS REPORTS AND COMMISSION STAFF RECOMMENDATION

In Order No. 12 filed on May 22, 2024, SP Utility Company, Inc. and Albury Manor Utility Company, Inc. were ordered to file monthly updates following approval of their sale and transaction to proceed. On June 22, 2024, SP Utility filed a monthly update. Since that date, no monthly updates have been filed.

In Order No. 13, the administrative law judge directed SP Utility Company, Inc. and Albury Manor Utility Company, Inc. to file a monthly update as required by ordering paragraph six in Order No. 12 and gave a deadline of October 1, 2024. To date, no monthly update or status report has been filed.


16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(j) provides that a transferee must provide a written update on the status of the transaction within 30 days of a Commission order approving a sale, transfer, merger, consolidation, acquisition, lease, or rental to proceed as proposed, and every 30 days thereafter until the transaction is complete.

By October 11, 2024, SP Utility and Albury Manor Utility must file a status report as required in Order No. 12.

By October 25, 2024, Commission Staff must file a recommendation on further processing of the application, including comments on whether the applicants' failure to file monthly updates as required in Order No. 12 and 16 TAC § 24.239(j) is grounds for voiding the approval of the sale and transaction.
