**ORDER NO. 15**  
**FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTS SUFFICIENT AND**  
**ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's October 22, 2024 recommendation regarding the closing documentation filed by SP Utility Company, Inc. and Albury Manor Utility Company, Inc. and its proposed procedural schedule for continued processing. On October 7, 2024, the applicants filed closing documents and a statement that there are no outstanding customer deposits held by Albury Manor Utility. Commission Staff recommended the closing documentation be found sufficient and that customer deposits have been properly addressed.

The administrative law judge finds the closing documentation sufficient and that customer deposits have been properly addressed.
