**ORDER NO. 1  
REQUIRING PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND  
DENYING REQUEST FOR A PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

On July 1, 2022, Entergy Texas, Inc. filed an application in Docket No. 53719<sup>1</sup> requesting authority to change its Texas retail rates. The application included a request for approval of new Transportation Electrification and Charging Infrastructure and Transportation Electrification and Charging Demand Adjustment riders.

In the Commission's Order Severing Issues filed on August 16, 2023, the two issues related to transportation electrification and charging were severed from Docket No. 53719 so they can be addressed in this proceeding.

The parties to Docket No. 53719 are deemed to be parties to this proceeding. By September 1, 2023, the parties must confer and file a proposed procedural schedule for processing this docket.

Additionally, Entergy's request for a prehearing conference is denied. A prehearing conference is premature at this time because no party has requested a hearing in this proceeding.
