**COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On August 15, 2023, Aqua Water Supply Corporation (Aqua WSC) filed an application to decertify a portion of its sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20962 in Bastrop County under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.254(a) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(d). Aqua WSC filed supplemental information on October 26, 2023, November 8, 2023, and December 5, 2024.

On February 2, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 6, directing the parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence along with proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs by April 3, 2024.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff is still working with Aqua WSC to prepare the joint motion to admit evidence, along with a proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests an extension of time until April 15, 2024 for Staff and Aqua WSC to provide a joint motion admit evidence, along with a proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the foregoing.
