ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the August 15, 2023 application of Aqua Water Supply Corporation to decertify a portion of its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity number 20962.

On September 15, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider the application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By October 16, 2023, the applicant must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the September 15, 2023 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed.

By November 15, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
