COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE

On August 16, 2023, Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) and Undine Texas, LLC (Undine Texas) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Calhoun County under the provisions of Texas Water Code § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239.

On August 21, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice, and both applicants and Commission Staff must file a recommendation regarding how to proceed with the application and propose a procedural schedule by September 18, 2023. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Ethan Blanchard, Rate Regulation Division, recommends that the application is administratively incomplete from a financial perspective. Staff further recommends that the Applicants be ordered to cure the deficiencies identified in Mr. Blanchard's memoranda by September 28, 2023 and that Staff be given a deadline of October 12, 2023 to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application.

II. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's deficiency recommendation, Staff does not propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the docket at this time. Staff intends to propose a procedural schedule alongside a subsequent recommendation that the application be found administratively complete. Staff notes that the Applicants should not issue notice until the application is deemed sufficient.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the application be found administratively incomplete, that the Applicants be ordered to file supplemental information to cure the deficiencies in the application by September 28, 2023 and that Staff be given a deadline of October 12, 2023, to file its supplemental recommendation. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with these recommendations.

On August 16, 2023, Undine Texas Environmental, LLC (Undine), CCN No. 20816, and Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority filed an application for the sale and transfer of facilities and customers in Calhoun County under the provisions of Texas Water Code § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239.

Undine has confidentially filed documentation concerning Undine's capitalization; however, these documents are dated February 2022 and are therefore stale.¹

I recommend that the application be deemed administratively incomplete from a financial perspective, and that the applicant be required to file the following information to cure the deficiencies:

- 1. Provide documentation demonstrating Undine's access to debt or equity financing (or both) from within the past six months.
- 2. Any documentation should specify the amount of funds that are unused and still available to Undine.
