**GRANTING EXTENSION AND AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**


This Order addresses Commission Staff's February 28, 2024 request to amend the procedural schedule established in Order No. 5. Commission Staff states that more time is needed to prepare its recommendation regarding approval of the sale and certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) amendment.

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff's request and amends the procedural schedule as follows:

<b>Event</b>	<b>Date</b>
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and CCN amendment	March 6, 2024
Deadline for applicants to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed	March 13, 2024
Deadline for any party to request a hearing	March 13, 2024
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and a proposed order approving the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed	March 27, 2024
120-day deadline for Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	April 18, 2024
