## COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON CLOSING DOCUMENTS AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On August 29, 2023, CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR-Texas) and Vineyard Ridge Water Supply, LLC (Vineyard Ridge) (collectively, 'Applicants') filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Gillespie County under Texas Water Code § 13.301 and Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239.

On April 15, 2024, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 10, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas to file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the Applicants' closing documents and to propose a procedural schedule within 15 days of the closing documents being filed. On June 3, 2024, CSWR-Texas filed notice of the completed transaction. Fifteen days from June 3, 2024 is June 18, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

## I. RECOMMENDATION ON THE SUFFICIENCY OF THE CLOSING DOCUMENTS

Staff has reviewed the closing documents filed by CSWR-Texas on June 3, 2024, and recommends that the Applicants have met the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.239.

Specifically, the sale and transfer was completed following the issuance of Order No. 10, wherein the transferee received notice from the Commission that a hearing would not be requested. Further, the closing documents were filed within 30 days after the effective date of the transaction and were signed by both the transferor and the transferee. Therefore, Staff

recommends a finding that the Applicants' closing documents are sufficient and satisfy 16 TAC § 24.239(a), (i), and (l).

Regarding customer deposits, the Applicants' closing documentation stated that there are no outstanding customer deposits associated with Vineyard Ridge.<sup>3</sup> Therefore, Staff recommends a finding that customer deposits have been adequately addressed as required by 16 TAC § 24.239(k) and (*l*).

For these reasons, Staff recommends that the Applicants have complied with the applicable closing requirements of 16 TAC § 24.239. Staff therefore recommends that the closing documents and customer deposit information be found sufficient.

#### II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's recommendation that the Applicants' closing documents be found sufficient, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the Applicants for review and consent	July 23, 2024
Deadline for the Applicants to file signed consent forms with the Commission	August 6, 2024
Deadline for parties to jointly file Proposed Notice of Approval, including findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	August 20, 2024

#### III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that an order be issued finding the Applicants' closing documents sufficient and adopting the proposed procedural schedule.
