COMMISSION STAFF'S FOURTH REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On September 1, 2023, Concho Rural Water Corporation (Concho), Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11361, filed an application to implement a pass-through gallonage charge (PTGC) for its Group 2 customers in accordance with its January 2023-June 2023 true-up report filed in compliance with its approved PTGC adjustment provision in its Water Utility Tariff, approved in the final order of Docket No. 49892.

On March 6, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 8, requiring Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation or request for hearing by March 20, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff is in contact with Concho and understands that Concho intends to file supplemental material in the coming days. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests a deadline of April 3, 2024 to file its final recommendation.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request for extension.
