**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING APPLICATION DEFICIENT**

The administrative law judge finds that the application does not meet the requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.259(e), as required by subsection (h)(1).

The presiding officer finds the application fails to satisfy 24.259(e) for the following reasons:

- 1) McClendon-Chisholm must identify the type of service that is to be provided in the municipality's requested area as required in 16 TAC § 24.259(e)(2)(B).
- 2) McClendon-Chisholm did not identify the municipally-owned utility or a franchised utility that will provide service to the requested area, and if each will serve part of the area, the area it will serve as required in 16 TAC § 24.259 (e)(2)(C).
- 3) McClendon-Chisholm did not identify with specificity any property that the municipality requests be transferred from the current CCN holder as required in 16 TAC § 24.259 (e)(2)(G).

In addition to the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff on October 30, 2023, McClendon-Chisholm must supplement the application to correct the deficiencies identified in this Order by November 30, 2023.

By January 5, 2023, Commission Staff shall comment on the application as supplemented.
