#### ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND PROVIDING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the November 7, 2023 application of MCC Utilities, LLC to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) and a sewer CCN in Harris County. On November 8, 2023, MCC filed a confidential attachment to its application.

On December 7, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By January 8, 2024, the applicant must cure the deficiencies described in the memoranda of Commission Staff experts Tsungirirai Gotora, David Lopez and Fred Bednarski III that are attached to Commission Staff's December 7, 2023 recommendation. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is found to be administratively complete.

By February 7, 2024, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application, comments on notice, and propose a procedural schedule.
