On November 21, 2023, Midway Water Utilities, Inc. (Midway) submitted its application for a minor tariff change pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25(b)(2). Midway requests to amend the name of the “Transfer Fee” to “Service Initiation Fee,” as well as other definitional revisions.

I reviewed the filing and did not identify any deficiencies for purposes of determining whether the application is administratively complete. Therefore, I recommend that the Commission deem the application administratively complete from a tariff review perspective.
