**ORDER NO. 9  
GRANTING MOTION TO RECONSIDER AND ABATING PROCEEDING**

On July 22, 2024 Commission Staff filed a motion to reconsider and a motion to abate this proceeding.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants the request for reconsideration. After reconsideration, the ALJ rescinds Order No. 8 and requires the City of Rockport to provide per-ratepayer information on refunds in the detail and format necessary for Commission Staff to provide a recommendation on the sufficiency of the refunds.

On July 15, 2024, Rockport indicated that it would take approximately six weeks to generate the report with the information required for Commission Staff to provide its recommendation. On July 22, 2024, Commission Staff filed a motion to abate this proceeding to allow Rockport the time it needs to provide the necessary reports.

The ALJ grants the motion and abates this proceeding. However, the ALJ requires updates on the progress being made. Beginning August 26, 2024, and by the first day of every month thereafter, the parties must file a report on the status of this proceeding. Any party may file a motion to lift the abatement at any time.
