**ORDER NO. 11  
REQUIRING RESPONSES**

This Order addresses the ratepayers of the City of Rockport's December 4, 2023 appeal of the Rockport's wholesale water and wastewater rates under Texas Water Code § 13.043(b).

On July 26, 2024, the City of Rockport filed proof of refund information and a re-urged motion to dismiss.

On August 15, 2024, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the City of Rockport's refunds in which it stated that there is not enough information to make a recommendation on the sufficiency of the refunds.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) looked at the information provided by the City of Rockport and agrees with Commission Staff and the petitioners, there is not enough information to make a recommendation on the sufficiency of the refunds. In addition, the ALJ will give the city more time, but not till December 31, 2024, and asks the city to refrain from complaining because it only wastes time, and instead to focus on providing the information required by Commission Staff. The ALJ requires the City of Rockport to provide the information required, as more fully described in the memorandum of Kathryn Eiland attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, by October 16, 2024.

By November 15, 2024, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the refunds.
