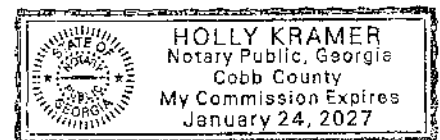

The original letter of credit was previously submitted to the Commission and a copy has been filed under seal in Project No. 37919 and item no. 1159. MXE continues to maintain at least one million dollars in shareholders' equity and will not make any distribution or other payment to any shareholders, affiliates, or corporate parent's affiliates if, after giving effect to the distribution or other payment, the REP's shareholders' equity is less than one million dollars.

MXE does not intend on collecting deposits or prepayments.
