PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS

ORDER GRANTING GOOD CAUSE EXCEPTION

On November 14, 2024, Electric Reliability Council of Texas, Inc. (ERCOT) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) a motion for a good cause exception pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.3(b) for an extension of the deadline established by 16 TAC § 25.508(b)(3), which requires ERCOT to file by December 1, 2024 the maximum number of megawatts of load shed that can be safely rotated during a loss of load event and a summary of the methodology used to calculate this value.

Under 16 TAC § 25.3(b), the Commission grants ERCOT a good cause exception to the deadline established by 16 TAC § 25.508(b)(3); this good cause exception is limited to an extension of the deadline from December 1, 2024 to February 6, 2025. Good cause exists due to the novelty of the magnitude determination process and accordingly to provide more time to gather additional information, as the Transmission Operators' responses to ERCOT's second Request for Information (RFI) are due by November 21, 2024 and further information and consultation may be necessary subsequently. ERCOT must file with the Commission the maximum number of megawatts of load shed that can be safely rotated during a loss of load event and a summary of the methodology used to calculate this value by February 6, 2025.
