Please provide a workpaper in Excel format with formulae intact showing how the Proposed Net Salvage in Exhibit DA W-1, Appendix C was calculated.

ANSWER:

Using experience and judgment, the net salvage factors found in Appendix C of Exhibit DAW-1, CenterPoint Houston Depreciation Study, are based on the net salvage analysis using actual company experience. The net salvage analysis computations requested are found in Appendix D of Exhibit DAW-1.
