**JOINT REQUEST FOR WRITTEN ORDER**

On March 28, 2024, Undine, LLC (Undine) filed a Class A rate application for authority to change water and wastewater rates under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.187. Undine is the holding company that owns the membership interests of the utilities in this application—Undine Texas, LLC, Undine Environmental, LLC, and Undine Development, LLC—that hold water Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) Nos. 12407 and 13260 and sewer CCN Nos. 20816, 20832, 20948, 21026, and 21029. On December 19, 2024, Undine filed an amended application. On March 11, 2025, Counsel for the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) filed an Order of Referral, referring this docket to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH).

At the prehearing conference on March 27, 2025, the SOAH administrative law judge (ALJ) ruled that June 22, 2025 is the effective date for purposes of Undine’s compliance with the notice requirement under TWC § 13.187(a-1) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.27(c)(1) regarding the notice that Undine most recently provided to water customers in Tejas Landing and sewer customers in Cold River Ranch. Specifically, June 22, 2025 is the date to which the proposed effective date of January 23, 2025 was suspended in Commission Order No. 13, pursuant to under TWC § 13.187(e) and 16 TAC § 24.33(a)(1).

For purposes of appealing such ruling under 16 TAC § 22.123(a), the Office of Public Utility Counsel, Woods of Greenshores Property Owners Association, Inc., Greenshores on Lake Austin Property Owners Association (collectively, Represented Intervenor), and Commission Staff (collectively, the Moving Parties) respectfully request that such oral ruling be reduced to a written order and included in the SOAH ALJ’s pending order adopting the Moving Parties’ joint proposed procedural schedule. Specifically, such request is related to the timing by which the Moving Parties must file an appeal on the effective date issue. The Moving Parties have conferred with Undine, who does not take a position on this request for a written order.

### **CONCLUSION**

The Moving Parties respectfully request that the ALJ reduce the oral ruling on the effective date issue in the SOAH ALJ's written order that would adopt the Moving Parties' joint proposed procedural schedule.
