## SOAH ORDER NO. 3 GRANTING INTERIM RATES, GRANTING MOTION TO ABATE, AND REQUIRING STATUS REPORT

On July 3, 2024, AEP Texas Inc. (AEP Texas) filed a pleading notifying the Administrative Law Judge that the parties have reached a settlement in principle that resolves all issues in this proceeding. Additionally, AEP Texas requests interim relief and an abatement of the proceeding. AEP Texas represents that all parties approve of the relief requested, except for Texas Industrial Energy Consumers, who is unopposed.<sup>1</sup>

The motion for interim relief is **GRANTED**. The Rider Mobile TEEE Facilities provided as Attachment B to AEP Texas's motion is **APPROVED ON AN INTERIM BASIS**, effective September 1, 2024. The interim rates are subject to refund or surcharge as provided in 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.125(e).

The motion to abate the proceeding is **GRANTED**. The parties shall file a complete settlement package or status report by **August 15, 2024**.
