COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

On April 5, 2024, Denton Oliver Creek, LP (Denton Oliver Creek) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Aqua Texas, Inc.'s (Aqua Texas) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 13201 in Denton County under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Denton Oliver Creek asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Denton County, which is a qualifying county.

On September 20, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, requiring the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on final disposition by October 29, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

T. RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the petition and supplemental information, and as detailed in the attached memorandum of Jaspinder Singh of the Infrastructure Division, recommends that the petition satisfies the requirements of TWC § 13.2541(b) and 16 TAC § 24.245(h). Additionally, the final water CCN map and certificate are attached to this filing. Staff recommends that the final map and certificate be provided to Aqua Texas and that Denton Oliver Creek be directed to file a certified copy of the CCN map and a boundary description of the CCN service area in the Denton County Clerk's office, as required by TWC § 13.257(r)-(s).

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully recommends the petition be approved and respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the foregoing.

On April 5, 2024, and August 1, 2024 (revised petition) Denton Oliver Creek, LP (Denton Oliver Creek) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Aqua Texas, Inc.'s (Aqua Texas) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13201 in Denton County, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Denton Oliver Creek asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Denton County, which is a qualifying county.

Denton Oliver Creek provided a special warranty deed confirming ownership of the tract of land within Aqua Texas's certificated service area. In addition, Denton Oliver Creek submitted a sworn affidavit attesting that the tract of land was not receiving water service from the CCN holder. Aqua Texas requested to intervene.


Based on the mapping review by Dave Babicki, Infrastructure Division, the revised maps and digital mapping data filed with Item 5 on June 5, 2024, and the same revised maps and digital mapping data filed with Item 10 on August 1, 2024, are all sufficient. It was determined that the tract of land in the petition for streamlined expedited release is approximately 559.7 acres, of which approximately 160.5 acres overlap Aqua Texas (CCN No. 13201) and would be decertified from CCN No. 13201.

Aqua Texas provided documentation clarifying that service facilities are immediately to the south and west of the property, and further stated that the property is receiving water service from Aqua Texas through its commitments to, existing facilities, and capacity proximate to the property.

In accordance with TWC § 13.2541 and 16 TAC § 24.245(h), Denton Oliver Creek met the Commission's requirements to allow for the release of the tract of land from Aqua Texas's

CCN No. 13201. Therefore, I recommend approval of the petition. Enclosed is a final map and certificate for Commission approval.

Additionally, I recommend that a final map and certificate be provided to the CCN holder.
