**ORDER NO. 4**  
**FINDING PETITION REMAINS ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND**  
**PROVIDING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the April 5, 2024 petition of Denton Oliver Creek, LP to amend Aqua Texas, Inc.'s certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 13201 in Denton County by streamlined expedited release.

On July 17, 2024, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition.

The administrative law judge finds the petition remains administratively incomplete and deficient.

By August 19, 2024, Denton Oliver Creek must cure the deficiencies in the petition described in the July 17, 2024 memorandum of Jaspinder Singh, attached to Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation.

By September 18, 2024, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the petition and the sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule for continued processing of the petition, if applicable.
