RE: Project No. 56497, Application of Carol Renewable Energy, LLC for a Power Generation Company Registration

RECOMMENDATION

On April 15, 2024, Carol Renewable Energy, LLC (Carol Renewable Energy) filed an application to register as a new power generation company (PGC) pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.109. The unit being registered is a 167.8 MW wind facility.

After reviewing Carol Renewable Energy's registration request, I have concluded that the applicant has satisfactorily completed the registration requirements under 16 TAC § 25.109(c) by providing contact information of the registrant and the registrant's primary and secondary emergency contacts; contact information of the current regulatory contact; information about each generating facility operated by the registrant; a description of the types of services provided by the registrant that relate to the generation of electricity; an oath or affirmation signed by a representative, official, officer or other authorized person was included with the application. Additionally, the registrant provided all the information required for PGC registration by 16 TAC § 25.109(d). The registrant provided an affidavit by a representative, official, officer, or other authorized person, the name of the registrant's corporate parent company, the names of the registrant's affiliates, and the applicable control number and item numbers of its initial Emergency Operations Plan (EOP). The registrant is not registered with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

Therefore, I recommend that the commission approve Carol Renewable Energy's registration request, and commission records be revised to reflect the registration.
