Docket No. 56531 – *Petition of Bobbie Williams to Amend City of Royse City's Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Collin County by Streamlined Expedited Release*

Before the Commission is a proposed order that addresses the petition of Bobbie Williams to amend the City of Royse City's certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Collin County by streamlined expedited release. I would approve the order with the following modifications.

The Commission should modify finding of fact 19 because there is inconclusive evidence in the record to support the finding of fact. Finding of fact 19 is based on a conclusory affidavit that is not substantiated by additional supporting documentation. The affidavit as a whole points toward actions to provide water and sewer service generally within the City's certificated area. The record does not provide a sufficient factual basis to determine the tract of land is receive water or sewer service.

Therefore, I recommend that finding of fact 19 be modified as follows:

19. The CCN holder has incurred costs to provide water and sewer service within its CCN area ~~developing plans to serve the tract of land~~, including developing its master utility and capital improvement plans and a plan to construct a 24-inch water line and a three million gallon elevated tank just south of the tract of land.

Finally, the Commission should delegate to the Office of Policy and Docket Management staff the authority to modify the order to conform to the *Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas* and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.

I look forward to discussing this matter with you at the open meeting.
