A revised proposed order in the above-referenced docket is posted for consideration and action by the Commission. If the Commission approves the revised proposed order, I recommend the following changes:

Proposed finding of fact 61 should be modified to accurately reflect Entergy Texas's *net* cost recovery<sup>1</sup> and for consistency with conclusion of law 29.

61. Entergy Texas's net cost recovery of \$10,521,070 \$1,775,060 consists of projected evaluation, measurement, and verification expenses allocated to Entergy Texas for the evaluation of program year 2024: an adjustment for Entergy Texas's net over-recovery, including interest, of program year 2023 energy efficiency costs; Entergy Texas's performance bonus earned in 2023; Entergy Texas's and Cities' rate-case expenses incurred in

Docket No. 54938; and an adjustment to remove \$1,253 from the total revenue requirement not associated with any particular issue. The amount of net cost recovery is reasonable.

Additionally, the Commission should delegate to the Office of Policy and Docket Management the authority to modify the order to conform to the Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.

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
