1. OCSC is made up of municipalities located within the service territory of Oncor Electric Delivery Company, LLC (Oncor).

2. On May 6, 2024, Oncor filed an application for approval for a system resiliency plan. OCSC's members, as well as their residents and businesses, may be adversely impacted by the relief requested by Oncor regarding its resiliency plan. Therefore, OCSC has a justiciable interest in this proceeding.

3. Additionally, OCSC has standing pursuant to Public Utility Regulatory Act (PURA) § 33.025.<sup>1</sup>
