SOAH ORDER NO. 5 ADMITTING EVIDENCE AND REMANDING TO COMMISSION

On July 29, 2024, Applicant Entergy Texas, Inc. (ETI) filed a Joint Motion to Cancel Remaining Procedural Schedule, Admit Evidence, and Remand to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) on behalf of ETI, Joe and Elizabeth Billnoske, David and Kerri Glockzin, Geoffrey and Pam Markham, and Commission Staff. The Motion was filed concurrently with the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement, resolving all issues in this proceeding.
