ORDER NO. 4 DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On May 21, 2024, George Wakileh filed a response to Order No. 3, filed on May 20, 2023, which required proof of his representation on behalf of the residents of Grand Lakes Municipal Utility District No. 2. Mr. Wakileh's brief requested the administrative law judge (ALJ) to reverse Order No. 3 and to drop or forgo the demand that he provide proof that the residents agreed that he would represent them before the Commission because he asserts that the requirement has already been met.

Having considered Mr. Wakileh's argument, the ALJ declines to reconsider Order No. 3. The deadline for Mr. Wakileh to file proof of representation established by Order No. 3, June 3, 2024, remains in effect. If Mr. Wakileh requires additional time to gather proof of representation, the ALJ will entertain a request for an extension of the deadline.

The ALJ is ruling on Mr. Wakileh's request promptly and without waiting for responses from Grand Lake MUD No. 2 and Commission Staff so that Mr. Wakileh may, if he wishes to do so, appeal Order No. 3 under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.123(a) within the short time frame allowed for such appeals.

To date, Mr. Wakileh has made several filings since order No. 3 was filed. Those filings will be addressed in a subsequent order.
