**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT**  
**AND DISMISSING CASE**

On February 25, 2025, Ratepayers filed a motion to withdraw the complaint and dismiss the matter with prejudice. Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code section 22.181(d)(10) and (g) (1), a party that initiated a proceeding may agree to withdraw its petition with prejudice at any time before the party has presented its direct case.

Accordingly, Ratepayers' motion is GRANTED, and the complaint is WITHDRAWN.

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code section 22.181(f)(2)(A), (3), dismissal is proper without the need for a remand when a complaint is withdrawn in this manner. Pursuant to the governing rules, this is a final order, and the complaint is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE from the dockets of the State Offices of Administrative Hearings and the Public Utility Commission of Texas.
