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**ORDER NO. 6  
ADMITTING EVIDENCE AND REMANDING TO COMMISSION**

On April 24, 2025, Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO) filed a Notice of Unanimous Agreement and Joint Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand Proceeding (Joint Motion) on behalf of all parties to the proceeding. SWEPCO notes the parties entered into a unanimous stipulation and agreement (Agreement) that resolves all issues in this proceeding.

The parties' motion is **GRANTED**. As requested, the following is **ADMITTED** as evidence:


1. SWEPCO's pre-filed exhibits and other documents, including SWEPCO's application, direct testimony, testimony exhibits,

  5. the direct testimony of Office of Public Utility Counsel witness Ms. Coyle filed on January 13, 2025;
  6. the direct testimony of Commission staff witness Mr. Cardoza filed on January 21, 2025;

  8. the rebuttal testimonies of SWEPCO witnesses Mr. Kimani, Ms. Chilcote, Mr. Koenig, and Mr. Johnston filed on February 11, 2025;
  9. the settlement testimony of SWEPCO witness Mr. Kimani in support of the Agreement filed on April 24, 2025; and
  10. the Agreement and all attachments filed on April 24, 2025.

Because the parties present an agreed Proposed Order that resolves all contested issues in this docket, it is **ORDERED** that this case is **DISMISSED** from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings without prejudice and **REMANDED** to the Commission for final processing and approval. 
