Dear Judges Quinn and Wiseman:

Cities have taken no position and will not file briefs in the above-referenced matter. No party has disputed that Entergy needs additional resources to meet its current and future capacity and energy needs. However, the cost of Entergy's proposed portfolio of dispatchable generation resources must also be considered.<sup>1</sup> Intervening parties and Commission Staff have raised concerns that Entergy's proposal may be too costly and will negatively impact customers. Entergy has the burden of demonstrating that the benefits of its proposal will outweigh its cost.
