Pumpage/Import Fee and Surface Water Fee Decrease

MSEC files this Notice of Modification of Pass-Through Provision and Rate Decrease pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.25(b)(2), as set forth herein.

MSEC is an independently owned water utility and a participant in a Groundwater Reduction Plan (Plan or GRP) entered into between the San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) and groundwater producers in Montgomery County, Texas to reduce production of groundwater in the county. MSEC is under the jurisdiction of the SJRA and subject to SJRA's rules and regulations. As part of the Plan, SJRA charges water use fees in the form of a Pumpage Fee to its participants based on groundwater that is produced in Montgomery County and purchased water costs in the form of a Surface Water Fee to those participants purchasing water under the Plan. MSEC is subject to both the Pumpage/Import Fee and the Surface Water Fee.

In Docket No. 53912, MSEC amended its tariff to allow for recovery of the amounts due to SJRA for the Pumpage/Import Fees and Surface Water Fees. MSEC determined that its water usage ratio was 82% groundwater and 18% surface water. MSEC blended the two fees in that proportion to calculate a pass-through rate, which was approved at \$3.64/1,000 gallons.

The pass-through rates are being adjusted to enable MSEC to fully recover the amounts paid to the water supplier or groundwater district due to a decrease in SJRA's fees to MSEC. Specifically, on June 24, 2024, the SJRA Board of Directors took formal action to adopt a rate decrease. This resulted in the Pumpage Fee and Import Fee to decrease from \$2.99/1,000 gallons to \$2.67/1,000 gallons, and the Surface Water Fee to decrease from \$3.41/1,000 gallons to \$3.26/1,000 gallons. These decreases will go into effect on September 1, 2024.

The noticed decrease by SJRA prompts this filing, in which MSEC provides updated calculations for:

(1) Line losses. As shown on Exhibit C-1, the actual line loss experience is 3.02%.

- (2) The ratio of groundwater to surface water subject to the two SJRA fees. As shown on Exhibit C-2, the current ratio for calendar year 2024 is estimated to be 100% groundwater (subject to the \$2.67/1,000 gallons Pumpage/Import Fee), and 0% surface water (subject to the \$3.26/1,000 gallons Surface Water Fee).
- (3) The difference between the amounts SJRA billed to MSEC and the amounts billed by MSEC to its customers on behalf of the SJRA Groundwater Reduction Plan. As shown on Exhibit C-3, the previous difference between these two figures netted a \$410,109.42 under-collection that resulted in a \$0.43/1,000 gallon true-up to customer bills (approved in Docket 53912). The current difference between these two figures, as of June 2024, is netting to a \$708,782.47 over-collection that resulted in a \$0.25/1,000 gallon true-up to customer bills. Further, MSEC requests a modification to its tariff to include the SJRA Blended Water Pass-Through Clause with True-Up, as shown on Exhibit D (Proposed Rate Schedule).

MSEC therefore requests to amend its tariff to allow for recovery of these fees under its tariff. MSEC also requests to refund customers the amount of fees over-collected, pursuant to the previous pass-through fee calculations, for a total pass-through of \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons used, such amount calculated to take into account SJRA's decreased fees.

MSEC will post electronically, email, and mail a Customer Notice of this Pass-Through Rate Change to all of its affected customers as required by 16 TAC § 24.25(b)(2)(F) on or about August 5, 2024, such change taking effect on September 1, 2024.

The Utility is a participant in a Groundwater Reduction Plan entered into between the San Jacinto River Authority ("SJRA") and groundwater producers in Montgomery County to reduce production of groundwater in the county.

Be advised that SJRA's Pumpage / Import Fee and Surface Water Fee for Participants has changed effective September 1, 2024. According to the SJRA, these fees generate the revenues necessary to pay for the operation and maintenance of the GRP facilities and to fund debt service.

On June 24, 2024, the **SJRA Board of Directors** approved an Amended Rate Order for GRP Participants effective September 1, 2024:

Pumpage / Import Fee to be charged each Participant is \$2.67 / 1,000 gallons. (\$2.75 / 1,000 gallons when adjusted for line loss)

Surface Water Fee to be charged each Participant is \$3.26 / 1,000 gallons. (\$3.36 / 1,000 gallons when adjusted for line loss)

This change by SJRA requires the Utility to provide you NOTICE under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25(b)(2)(F) of a TARIFF RATE REVISION as follows:

San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA)......\$2.50* per 1,000 gallons
*(The Pass Through Fees are a blended rate adjusted for line loss and include a true-up
adjustment.

The Present Calculation and the New Calculation of the Customer Billing applicable to your billing, including the SJRA Pumpage/Import Fee and Surface Water Fee, are set out on the following pages.

This tariff change is being implemented in accordance with the minor tariff changes allowed by 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25. The cost to you as a result of this change will not exceed the costs charged to your utility.

Notice of Groundwater Reduction Plan (GRP) Fiscal Year 2025 Rates for Participants Effective September 1, 2024

June 28, 2024

Dear Participants,

On June 24, 2024, the GRP Review Committee voted to recommend adoption of the proposed GRP Fiscal Year 2025 Operating Budget and to reduce both the groundwater pumpage and surface water delivery wholesale rates for GRP Participants. The motion passed with five votes in favor, and one absent. The San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) Board of Directors also approved the reduction in wholesale water rates on June 27, 2024.

Effective September 1, 2024, the Pumpage Fee and Import Fee will decrease to the rate of \$2.67 per 1,000 gallons, and the Surface Water Fee will decrease to the rate of \$3.26 per 1,000 gallons.

These fees generate the revenues necessary to pay for the operation and maintenance of the GRP facilities and to fund debt service. SJRA strives to effectively manage the costs of operation and maintenance of the GRP facilities so that the lowest possible fees are adopted under the Rate Order.

PURCHASED WATER AND/OR DISTRICT FEE PASS THROUGH CLAUSE:

Changes in fees imposed by any non-affiliated third party water supplier or underground water district having jurisdiction over the Utility shall be passed through as an adjustment to the water gallonage charge according to the following formula:

$$R = G / (1 - L)$$

Where:

R =the proposed pass-through rate;

G = the new gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons) by source supplier;

L = the actual line loss for the preceding 12 months, not to exceed 15%.

The SJRA pass-through fee is based on blended surface water and ground water at different costs per 1,000 gallons. MSEC is required to annually true up amounts paid for SJRA charges to amounts charged to customersover the true up period from June 1 through May 31. The true up adjustment should be filed by June 30 following the true up period. The resulting over or under charge shall be rolled into the rates to be charged for the next true up period. In the event that system line loss exceeds 15% and is not justified as reasonable and necessary by the utility, recovery of line loss will be limited to 15% and will not be recovered through the true up process. The true-up must be calculated using the following formula:

$$AG = [(AGp * p\%) + (AGs * s\%)] + TU$$

Where:

AG = adjusted gallonage charge, rounded to nearest one cent

AGp = adjusted gallonage charge for SJRA Pumpage and Import Fee

p% = cumulative total permitted gallns pumped divided by cumulative total permitted gallons

AGs = adjusted gallonage charge for SJRA Surface Water Fee

s% = cumulative total permitted surface water divided by cumulative total permitted gallons

TU = previous true-up amount + \$ paid to SJRA - \$ billed to customers) divided by previous 12 months' total cumulative gallons

FEDERAL TAX CHANGE CREDIT RIDER (FTCCR):

The Federal Tax Change Credit Rider gives effect to the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, which changed the federal corporate tax rate from 35% to 21%, by reducing the cost of service paid by customers taking service under this rate tariff. The FTCCR will provide credits to customers taking service under this rate tariff.
