**COMMISSION STAFF’S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE
COMPLETENESS OF THE APPLICATION, NOTICE, AND PROPOSED
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On August 5, 2024, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. (MSEC) filed an application for a pass-through rate change for water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12887 related to water use fees imposed by San Jacinto River Authority, with a proposed effective date of September 1, 2024.

On August 7, 2024, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 1, requiring the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice, and to propose a procedural schedule, by September 4, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND
NOTICE**

Staff has reviewed the application and notice and recommends that it is sufficient for further review pursuant to the requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25(b)(2)(F). Staff does not comment on the merits of the application at this time.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule for further processing:

Deadline for MSEC’s response to Staff’s recommendation or to request a hearing	November 14, 2024
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to submit a proposed order that includes findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	December 6, 2024

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests that MSEC's application and notice be deemed sufficient and that the procedural schedule above be adopted for continued processing of this matter.
