On August 23, 2024, Southwestern Public Service Company ("SPS"), doing business as Xcel Energy, filed an application ("Application") with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") and with each Texas municipality that has original jurisdiction over SPS's electric rates, to amend its Interruptible Credit Option Tariff ("ICO Tariff"), for approval of a new, voluntary tariff referred to as the Southwest Power Pool Integrated Marketplace Demand Response Option Tariff ("SPP IM Tariff"), and for approval of a new, voluntary rider referred to as the Off-Peak Alternate Rider for eligible customers taking service under SPS's Secondary General Service, Primary General Service, and Large General Service - Transmission Tariffs. SPS's Application was assigned Docket No. 56921 and is styled *Application of Southwestern Public Service Company to Amend its Interruptible Credit Option Tariff, and for Approval of a Southwest Power Pool Integrated Marketplace Demand Response Option Tariff and an Off-Peak Alternate Rider*.

SPS's ICO Tariff customers will be affected by the relief requested in this Application. SPS's proposed SPP IM Tariff and Off-Peak Alternate Rider are new, voluntary programs available to eligible customers who elect to participate. Because these offerings are new and have not yet been approved by the Commission, they do not affect SPS's current customers. SPS is requesting an effective date of October 18, 2024 for the tariffs.

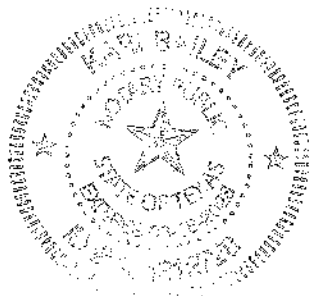

caused by the disaster and businesses directly impacted by the disaster," Sánchez said.

Small nonfarm businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, small businesses engaged in aquaculture and most private nonprofit organizations of any size may qualify for Economic Injury Disaster Loans of up to \$2 million

to help meet financial obligations and operating expenses which could have been met had the disaster not occurred.

"Eligibility for these loans is based on the financial impact of the disaster only and not on any actual property damage. These loans have an interest rate of 4 percent for businesses and 3.25 percent for private nonprofit organizations, a maximum

term of 30 years and are available to small businesses and most private nonprofits without the financial ability to offset the adverse impact without hardship," Sánchez said.

Interest does not begin to accrue until 12 months from the date of the initial disaster loan disbursement. SBA disaster loan repayment begins 12 months from the date of the first disbursement.

NOTICE OF ELECTION By the TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

In accordance with the provisions of the Texas Agriculture Code, Chapter 74, Subchapter D, and 4 Tex. Admin. Code, Chapter 3, Subchapter A, the Texas Department of Agriculture (the Department) will conduct a board election in the Northern High Plains Eradication Zone, in order to select a representative of the above-referenced zone to serve on the Texas Boll Weevil Eradication Foundation Board of Directors. The board is charged with administering the boll weevil eradication program in Texas.

The Northern High Plains Eradication Zone consists all of Swisher and Hale counties; that part of Randall County that lies south and east of a line running along Highway 60 from the Deaf Smith County line east to Interstate 27, then running north along interstate 27 to the Potter County line; the part of Armstrong County that lies west and south of a line running along FM 294 from the Carson County line to Hwy 287; then running due south to Mulberry Creek; then running east along Mulberry creek to the Donley County line; the part of Briscoe County that lies west of a line running along Hackberry Creek from its intersection with the Armstrong County line to its intersection with the Prairie Dog Town Fork of the Red River; continuing south along Cherokee Creek from its intersection with the Prairie Dog Town Fork of the Red River to County Road 27; continuing south along County Road 27 to Hwy 256; continuing west along Hwy 256 to the Caprock escarpment; and continuing south along the Caprock escarpment to the Floyd County line; and the part of Floyd County that lies south and west of a line running along FM 97 beginning at the Motley County line; continuing west to the Caprock escarpment; and continuing north along the Caprock escarpment to the Briscoe County line.

Any cotton grower having planted cotton in the year 2023 within the zone defined above is eligible to vote, and, if he or she resides in the Northern High Plains Eradication Zone and has at least seven years experience as a cotton grower, can have his or her name placed on the ballot as a candidate in the board member election. A cotton grower is defined as a person who grows cotton intended to be commercial cotton. The term includes an individual who, as owner, landlord, tenant or sharecropper, is entitled to share in the cotton grown and available for marketing from the farm or share in the proceeds from the sale of the cotton from the farm or from an indemnity or other payment received from or related to the planting, growing, or failure of the cotton. Any person eligible to vote in the board member election that resides in the Northern High Plains Eradication Zone and meets the seven-year experience requirement may place their name in nomination for election to the Texas Boll Weevil Eradication Foundation Board by written application to the Department at the address provided below. Kotb is leaving the ‘Today’ show: ‘Time for me to turn the page’

Hoda Kotb is saying goodbye to the “Today” show.

Kotb became emotional as she shared the news live on the NBC show on Thursday morning. She said turning 60 last month was a “monumental” moment for her that made her think about the decade ahead.

“I realized that it was time for me to turn the page at 60, and to try something new,” she said, adding, “This is the right time for me to move on.”

Kotb also said that her children deserve a “bigger piece of my time pie.” She plans to leave “Today” in early 2025.

Kotb’s co-anchor Savannah Guthrie also became emotional during the Thursday segment, telling her that “we love you so much” and that no one at the show wants to “imagine this place without you.”

In a letter to “Today” staff shared on Today.com, Kotb said she will stay with the “NBC family” after leaving the show.

DeGeneres says she went to therapy amid workplace scandal

Ellen DeGeneres is opening up about the fallout from her toxic workplace scandal in what she claims will be the final comedy special of her career.

The comedian, 66, released her latest special, “Ellen DeGeneres: For Your Approval,” Tuesday on Netflix, in which she announces to viewers early on, “I got kicked out of show business because I’m mean. Yeah, you can’t be mean and be in show business.” She later describes this as the “second time I’ve been kicked out of show business,” referring to backlash she faced after coming out as gay in the 1990s.

“Eventually, they’re going to kick me out a third time for being old,” she quips. “Mean, old and gay. The triple crown.”

In 2020, DeGeneres faced claims that her daytime talk show was a toxic workplace, with BuzzFeed News citing current and former employees who alleged racism, fear and intimidation while working on the show. Addressing the claims that year, the comedian said she “learned that things happened here that never should have happened” and apologized “to the people who were affected.” She ended her talk show in 2022.

Tatum and Dewan’s divorce nears an end after 6 years

Channing Tatum and Jenna Dewan’s drawn-out divorce is nearing an end after nearly six years.

On Wednesday, the former couple’s lawyers filed a stipulated judgment for the judge to sign and effectively finalize their divorce. In the filing, obtained by USA TODAY, Tatum and Dewan’s attorneys said the two have signed off on a written agreement – a “further stipulated judgment on reserved issues” – that resolves “all remaining issues in this case.”

The two have agreed on how to separate their property and assets as well as resolve child and spousal support issues. Dewan and Tatum, who share custody over 11-year-old daughter Everly Tatum and have both moved on to new partners, mutually waived spousal support.

Dewan, who stars on ABC’s “The Rookie,” is engaged to musician Steve Kazee, and the couple share two children. Tatum is reportedly engaged to actress Zoë Kravitz, according to Today and People magazine. He starred in her directorial debut, “Blink Twice,” which was released in theaters last month.

Chrisley’s 7-year sentence upheld as she loses bid for reduced time

“Chrisley Knows Best” star Julie Chrisley will continue to serve her seven-year prison sentence for tax evasion and bank fraud, a federal judge has ordered.

The former reality star, 51, appeared in federal court in Atlanta on Wednesday morning for a sentencing hearing three months after the 11th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals found that the lower court miscalculated Chrisley’s prison time, citing lack of evidence of her full involvement in the bank fraud scheme for which she and husband Todd Chrisley were sentenced.

According to a court filing obtained by USA TODAY, U.S. District Judge Eleanor L. Ross upheld her 2022 ruling and gave “justification for the sentence imposed” during the 50-minute hearing. Chrisley was sentenced to 84 months of incarceration, five years of supervised release and more than \$4.7 million – the total amount prosecutors said she obtained illegally – in restitution.

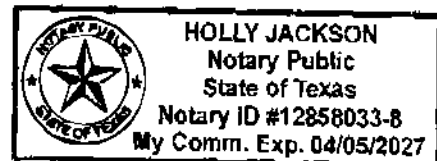

Code, Chapter 3, Subchapter A, the Texas Department of Agriculture (the Department) will conduct a board election in the Northern High Plains Eradication Zone, in order to select a representative of the above-referenced zone to serve on the Texas Boll Weevil Eradication Foundation Board of Directors. The board is charged with administering the boll weevil eradication program in Texas.

The Northern High Plains Eradication Zone consists all of Swisher and Hale counties; that part of Randall County that lies south and east of a line running along Highway 60 from the Deaf Smith County line east to Interstate 27, then running north along interstate 27 to the Potter County line; the part of Armstrong County that lies west and south of a line running along FM 294 from the Carson County line to Hwy 287; then running due south to Mulberry Creek; then running east along Mulberry creek to the Donley County line; the part of Briscoe County that lies west of a line running along Hackberry Creek from its intersection with the Armstrong County line to its intersection with the Prairie Dog Town Fork of the Red River; continuing south along Cherokee Creek from its intersection with the Prairie Dog Town Fork of the Red River to County Road 27; continuing south along County Road 27 to Hwy 256; continuing west along Hwy 256 to the Caprock escarpment; and continuing south along the Caprock escarpment to the Floyd County line; and the part of Floyd County that lies south and west of a line running along FM 97 beginning at the Motley County line; continuing west to the Caprock escarpment; and continuing north along the Caprock escarpment to the Briscoe County line.

Any cotton grower having planted cotton in the year 2023 within the zone defined above is eligible to vote, and, if he or she resides in the Northern High Plains Eradication Zone and has at least seven years experience as a cotton grower, can have his or her name placed on the ballot as a candidate in the board member election. A cotton grower is defined as a person who grows cotton intended to be commercial cotton. The term includes an individual who, as owner, landlord, tenant or sharecropper, is entitled to share in the cotton grown and available for marketing from the farm or share in the proceeds from the sale of the cotton from the farm or from an indemnity or other payment received from or related to the planting, growing, or failure of the cotton. Any person eligible to vote in the board member election that resides in the Northern High Plains Eradication Zone and meets the seven-year experience requirement may place their name in nomination for election to the Texas Boll Weevil Eradication Foundation Board by written application to the Department at the address provided below. Nomination forms are provided by the Department and must be signed by the nominee and at least ten other eligible voters. The nomination form must be received by the Department at its office located in Austin by October 31, 2024, and must provide the legal residence of the applicant. A nomination form may be obtained by contacting the Department office or any Texas A&M AgriLife Extension office located in the voting area.

The board election will be held by mail-in-balloting. If there is more than one candidate, ballots will be mailed to cotton growers following the nomination deadline. All ballots cast by mail must be postmarked no later than December 13, 2024, to be valid. If an election is uncontested, the sole nominee will be automatically instated as director, in lieu of a formal election taking place.
