## ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS AND ENTERING PROTECTIVE ORDER

This Order addresses the August 23, 2024 application of Southwestern Public Service Company (SPS) to amend its interruptible credit option tariff, approval of a Southwest Power Pool integrated marketplace demand response option tariff, and approval of an off-peak alternate rider. SPS proposed an effective date of October 18, 2024.

SPS proposes to provide notice: (1) to its customers taking service under its existing interruptible credit option tariff, (2) by a one-time publication in newspapers of general circulation in SPS' service area, and (3) by filing applications with the municipalities retaining original jurisdiction over SPS's rates.

SPS requests entry of a protective order for this proceeding. Accordingly, the administrative law judge enters the standard protective order attached to this Order to govern the use of confidential and highly sensitive documents in this proceeding, which must remain in place unless otherwise ordered.

By September 9, 2024, Commission Staff must file comments and recommendations on the application, the sufficiency of the proposed notice, and propose a procedural schedule for processing. Signed at Austin, Texas on the 26th day of August 2024.
