ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
PROPOSED NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ENTERING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the August 23, 2024 application of Southwestern Public Service Company (SPS) to amend its interruptible credit option tariff, approval of a Southwest Power Pool integrated marketplace demand response option tariff, and approval of an off-peak alternate rider.


On September 9, 2024, Commission Staff recommended that the application be found sufficient, that SPS's proposed method of notice be found sufficient, and proposed a procedural schedule for further processing.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively complete and the proposed notice sufficient. The following procedural schedule applies for further processing:

Event	Date
Deadline for SPS to file proof of notice	October 7, 2024
Deadline to intervene; deadline for intervenor comment or request for hearing	October 7, 2024
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and final disposition	October 14, 2024
Deadline for SPS to respond to Commission Staff's final recommendation or request for hearing	October 21, 2024
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to submit a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order that includes findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	October 28, 2024
