## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND PROPOSED NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the September 3, 2024, application of the City of Lubbock, acting by and through Lubbock Power & Light, to revise its wholesale transmission service credit to incorporate changes to the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) four-coincident-peak (4CP) billing units in compliance with ordering paragraph number 3 of the Notice of Approval in Docket No. 55439.<sup>1</sup>

On October 3, 2024, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application, proposed notice, and proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and sufficient for further review. Additionally, the ALJ finds the proposed notice sufficient.

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing:

Deadline to intervene	21 days from the date service of notice is completed
Deadline for LP&L to file proof of notice	October 18, 2024
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule for further processing	October 25, 2024
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a final recommendation	October 30, 2024
