That, LANDOWNER, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration to us in hand paid by the CITY PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD OF SAN ANTONIO, a Municipal Board of the CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, created pursuant to the authority contained in Section 1502.070 of the Government Code, and its predecessor statute; the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed, has granted, sold and conveyed and by these presents does grant, sell and convey unto the CITY OF SAN ANTONIO in Bexar County, Texas, as part of its electric and gas system, ("Grantee"), a one hundred foot wide permanent easement and right-of-way for overhead electric transmission lines and electric distribution lines, each line to consist of a variable number of wires and cables, conduits, and all necessary or desirable appurtenances (including towers and/or poles made of wood, metal or other materials, props and guys), and a communication system at or near the location, and along the general course now located and staked out by Grantee, over, across, upon, and under the following described lands located in Bexar County, Texas, to-wit:

# [Property Description]

Said easement and right-of-way being more particularly described and shown by field notes and drawings marked Exhibits "A" and "B", respectively, attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Together with the right of ingress and egress over, across and along said easement and right-of-way, for the purpose of inspecting, patrolling, constructing, reconstructing, installing, maintaining, removing and replacing said lines and appurtenances, including poles, towers and wires; the right to relocate said lines and appurtenances within said right-of-way, the right to remove from said lands by standard industry practices employed in vegetation management, all trees, and parts thereof, and any vegetation or obstructions which endanger or may interfere with the efficiency of said lines or their appurtenances; and Grantor agrees that no building or structure of any kind will hereafter be erected or placed by Grantor, Grantor's heirs, successors, assigns and legal representatives, on said easement and right-of-way herein granted, so long as this easement remains in effect; and the right of exercising all other rights hereby granted.

Grantee shall have the full right to determine when, and which trees are to be removed from the right-of-way above described, to the extent that all of the trees and parts thereof situated on such right-of-way may be removed under the terms of this instrument.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described easement and rights unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, until the use of said easement and right-of-way is abandoned.

And Grantor does hereby bind herself, her heirs, successors, assigns and legal representatives to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described easement and rights unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
