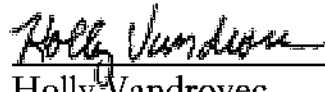

III. CORRECTING INTERVENOR NAME

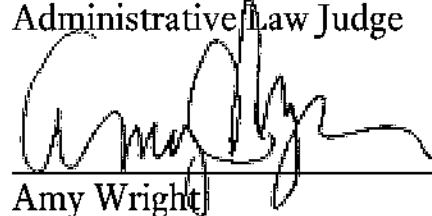
The ALJs note that the correct name of the intervenor is Capitol Aggregates, Inc. as stated in the intervenor's filing at Interchange Item No. 181.
