
MODIFICATION OF THE DIRECT TESTIMONY OF JAMES R. ANDRUS

"On behalf of the Steinle Group, I would like to modify my Direct Testimony. After careful review of the filings in this Docket and following discussions with other Intervenors and affected landowners, the Steinle Group maintains its absolute opposition to any route utilizing Segment 83, but **no longer opposes the use of Segments 77 or 87.**"
