We are submitting this letter in protest to the proposed New Electric Transmission Line that will affect my land/property.

I am a military retiree and a 100% Disabled Veteran with numerous health issues that include PTSD, Migraine Headaches, Diabetes and Diabetes associated conditions and asthma. We are having to live with a sandpit behind my land that is adversely affecting us and our fellow Ranchers. We were not advised or informed that this silica extracting plant was coming into our area or made aware of any Impact Studies before the plant was constructed.

Likewise, our neighbors and us did not receive notice of a fact-based informational meeting supposably held at our local high school. So, this news has caught us off-guard. Powerlines going thru our land definitely poses a health threat to me and would intensify my condition with severe migraines since high powerlines close to dwellings can cause headaches and migraine headaches to inhabitants.

Furthermore, we strongly that having towering light poles or towers will depreciate the value of our land. Also, it would make it difficult to sell our land with those unsightly structures/objects on our land.
