**APPLICATION OF ENTERGY TEXAS, § PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION
INC. TO AMEND ITS DISTRIBUTION §
COST RECOVERY FACTOR § OF TEXAS**

COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On September 20, 2024, Energy Texas, Inc. (ETI) filed an application to amend its distribution cost recovery factor (DCRF) effective November 19, 2024. ETI requests that the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) approve a DCRF tariff to recover investments ETI made during the period from April 1 through June 30, 2024. This is ETI's second DCRF filing since the end of its last comprehensive base-rate proceeding, Docket No. 53719.¹

On September 24, 2024, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 1, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Commission and ETI to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order by October 31, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for the filing of any documents be extended for good cause. The parties require additional time to complete their joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to file the joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order be extended until November 4, 2024. Staff has conferred with Laura Kennedy, Senior Counsel for ETI, and James Z. Zhu, attorney for Texas Industrial Energy Consumers (TIEC), and is authorized to represent that ETI and TIEC agree with the extension request. To date, Staff has been unable to confirm Cities' stance on the extension request.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to file the joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order be extended until November 4, 2024.
