Provide responses to the Requests for Information by filing with the Commission solely through the Interchange on the Commission's website and provide notice, by email, to all other parties that the pleading or document has been filed with the Commission, unless otherwise ordered by the presiding officer pursuant to the Second Order Suspending Rules in Project No. 50664.

DEFINITIONS

- "EPE" or "you" refers to that El Paso Electric Company and any person acting or purporting to act on their behalf, including without limitation, attorneys, agents, advisors, investigators, representatives, employees, or other persons.

- Staff 1-1 Were any outages during the reconciliation period caused by imprudent management of EPE's generating facilities or caused by vendor errors? If so, what were the replacement costs associated with the outages, and what is the appropriate rate treatment to be reflected in EPE's fuel balance?
- Staff 1-2 During the reconciliation period, did EPE prudently manage its (1) generation of electricity; (2) maintenance of its generating facilities; and (3) dispatch of its generating units?
- **Staff 1-3** Did EPE properly apply reasonable line-loss factors in determining reconcilable fuel balances for each rate class?
 - a) What line-loss factors were used?
 - b) What was the source of the line-loss values?
- **Staff 1-4** What are EPE's appropriate energy- and demand-loss factors?
- Staff 1-5 What efforts and progress has EPE made in minimizing forced outages due to personnel or contractor errors at its Newman station in accordance with the final order in Docket No. 54142?
 - a) Include a description of the root causes and estimated replacement power and capitalized repair costs incurred for any outages at the Newman station during the reconciliation period that were related to EPE personnel or contractor errors.
- Staff 1-6 Has EPE complied with previous Commission orders concerning performance standards for the Palo Verde nuclear generating station?
