II. Background

Acclaim Energy is an energy management consulting firm that provides services such as energy procurement, risk management, and on-site distributed energy to businesses, local governments, municipal utility districts, hospitals, and educational institutions. To date, Acclaim Energy has delivered more than \$700 million in savings to its clients.

On January 31, 2025, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC ("CenterPoint Energy")

filed its transmission and distribution system resiliency plan for review and approval (“Resiliency Plan”). As part of its proposed Resiliency Plan, CenterPoint Energy requests approval of a utility-scale microgrid pilot program, the purpose of which is to allow CenterPoint Energy to assess the performance of participating microgrids during extreme weather events.

III. Request to Intervene
